

Chromebook Simply Coding Intro to Websites

Chromebooks save everything to the cloud (your google drive account) meaning they don't have a traditional desktop (at least not one with a lot of space). Because of this, here are a few steps to follow to get everything to work.


- 1. Chromebooks can't install Sublime Text, but they have a great coding editor named Caret. See below
- 2. Download the app Caret from the chrome web store.
 - (a) https://chrome.google.com/webstore/detail/caret/fljalecfjciodhpcledpamjachpmelml?h l=en
 - i. Make sure you go through all the steps to install it, add app/launch app.
 - (b) It's a code editor that works great for HTML, CSS & JavaScript, similar to Sublime Text.
 - i. Every time you see Sublime Text in the lesson activities, know that if you're on a Chromebook then you'll be using CARET!
- 3. Next, you need to create a new folder in your downloads folder.
 - (a) Open your folder named Files:




- (b) Right Click on the Downloads folder and select New folder.
 - i. See the image below.




(c) Name the new folder **Coding**, then press enter.




4. Now you need to save your HTML coding file to your new Coding folder.






- (b) COMPLETE UP TO LESSON 1.3 ACTIVITY. SKIP STEPS 1 & 2. DO STEP 3. AFTER STEP 3 (of 1.3 Activity in the Simply Coding Lessons) FOLLOW THE STEPS BELOW TO SAVE YOUR FILE
- (c) Click on File > Save or do CTRL + S




(d) Navigate to your new **Coding** folder and NAME your new file **reference.html** and save it. See the image below.




If you've done it correctly, you'll see a file named reference.html inside your Coding folder.

5. Opening Your Code in the Browser:

- (a) You do this when you want to see what your code has created!
- (b) This first happens in Lesson 1.4 but will be a common occurrence during the course.
- (c) SKIP LESSON 1.4 OF SIMPLY CODING AND FOLLOW THE STEPS BELOW.
- (d) Open the coding folder where you saved your coding.html file.
 - i. My files > Downloads > Coding
- (e) RIGHT-CLICK on the reference.html file and select 'Open with'
 - i. See image below.



(f) Then click on View



- i. This will display your code in the browser, leave that tab open so you don't have to do these steps again!
- ii. When you add or edit your code in your caret editor, just save your file and then click on the browser tab with your website and press refresh.
- 6. Continue to Lesson 1.5 of the Intro to Websites course.
 - (a) Refer to this sheet for help with opening or saving files. REMEMBER that you're using the caret editor instead of Sublime text (as the lessons often reference).
